HBCU BOOK SCHOLARSHIP



ELIGIBILITY AND SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Must provide proof of enrollment in **Selma University** for the academic year **2021-2022**. (Note: Proof of enrollment will be required before an award is issued).
- 2. Must submit an official transcript showing your cumulative GPA (Note: An official transcript will be required before an award is issued).
- 3. Provide a list of leadership, community service, and extra-curricular activities that you are a part of, and provide any leadership positions held.
- 4. Complete a 200-word essay on the following topic: *How has your community service affected your plans for the future?*
- 5. Sign and date Application and Authorization Release.


